THE POINT: Friendship is a Gift

BIBLE STORY: David and Jonathan | | 1 Samuel 18:1-5, 1 Samuel 20

AGE: Grade 3 - Grade 6



Discover the story of David and Jonathan

Learn that David and Jonathan were faithful friends

Understand that friendship is a gift from God

BIBLE CONTEXT

David and Jonathan grew up very differently. Jonathan was the eldest son of king Saul. He grew up in a palace, surrounded by the best food, great and mighty soldiers and anything he could ever need. David was the youngest and had seven older brothers and he spent most of his time in a field looking after sheep.

As a young man when David wasn't hanging with sheep, he served Saul in the palace playing the harp. After David defeated Goliath he joined king Saul's army and became close friends with Jonathan, the Bible describes that they became one in spirit and made a covenant friendship. They were faithful friends through many trials and challenges.

MEMORY VERSE

Proverbs 17:17 (NIV) - A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity.

- Cut out a heart shape from cardboard and on one side write "A friend loves at all times." on the other side write "and a brother is born for a time of adversity. Proverbs 17:17
- Stick a paper straw or paddle pop stick on the base of the heart. Show the children one side
 of the heart and have them repeat after you, "a friend loves at all times", then flip the
 heart to show the other side, "and a brother is born for a time of adversity. Proverbs 17:17"
- Practise this a few times until the children have memorised the verse.









SMALL GROUP GUIDE - PAGE 1

START THE CONVERSATION

Encourage the children to think of one word that they would use to describe someone who is a great friend. Go around the group and invite children to share their words. (It's ok if children say a word that someone else has shared before.)

DISCUSSION GUIDE - GRADE 3 - 4

- Jonathan grew up in the palace and David grew up taking care of sheep. How did David and Jonathan become friends?
- Read about David and Jonathan in I Samuel 23:16 (NIV), "And Saul's son Jonathan went to David at Horesh and helped him find strength in God." How can we be the type of friend that helps others find strength?
- Why is it important to have good friends and be a good friend?

DISCUSSION GUIDE - GRADE 5 - 6

- Read about David and Jonathan in I Samuel 20:42 (NIV), "Jonathan said to David, "Go in peace, for we have sworn friendship with each other in the name of the Lord, saying, Lord is witness between you and me, and between your descendants and my descendants forever.' " How were David and Jonathan faithful friends?
- Read some more about David and Jonathan in I Samuel 23:16 (NIV), "And Saul's son Jonathan went to David at Horesh and helped him find strength in God." How can we be the type of friend that helps others find strengtH?
- Why is it important to have good friends and be a good friend, and why do you thinks its an amazing gift to have a close friend you can always trust?

ACTIVITY

Give each child a sheet of notepaper and a pen or marker and encourage them to write a short note to a friend to tell them something they appreciate about their friendship.

SUPPLIES

- Note paper
- Envelopes
- Pens or markers


